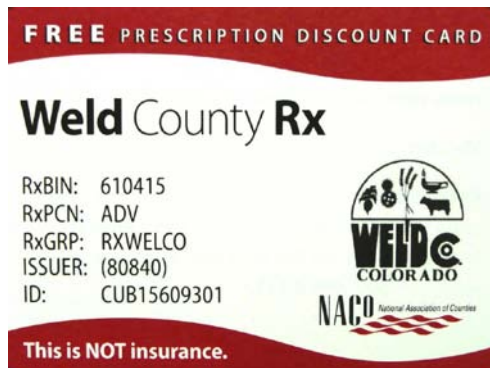

### FREE DISCOUNT PRESCRIPTION DRUG CARD OFFERS WELD RESIDENTS SAVINGS ON MEDICATION

WELD COUNTY, CO – Weld County residents wanting to save money on prescription medication can now take advantage of a discount prescription drug card program made available by the Weld County Board of Commissioners through the National Association of Counties (NACo).



The card is free, available to all Weld County residents, and offers up to a 24% discount of prescription drugs not covered by health insurance or Medicare or if you need a prescription drug but do not have medical insurance.

“We understand the difficulties many residents have when they need to pay for prescriptions – many of which can be quite costly,” said Chairman of the Board of Weld County Commissioners Sean Conway. “This card can provide some assistance to reduce the costs of prescriptions not covered by insurance, and it does so at no cost to the user or to the county.”

The card is available at the Weld County Department of Public Health, the Weld County Administration Building or online at [www.caremark.com/naco](http://www.caremark.com/naco) -- just follow the simple on-screen instructions to obtain and immediately print your discount card.
