COMMISSIONERS SEEK APPLICANTS FOR LOCAL BOARDS

WELD COUNTY, CO – The Weld County Commissioners are seeking Weld County residents interested in volunteering to serve on the: Planning Commission, Child Protection Citizen Review Panel, Board of Public Health, and Noxious Weed Management Advisory Board.

The Planning Commission conducts hearings and advises regarding land-use planning, zoning administration, and subdivision development within the county, and reviews and makes recommendations on land-use applications and amendments to policies and regulations. This board meets the first and third Tuesdays of each month at 1:30 p.m., and the time commitment is 10 hours monthly. *One position open for an applicant who lives in School District RE-6 (west of 14th Avenue in Evans or Greeley) and one position open for an applicant who lives in School District RE-2, RE-4, or RE-10 (Eaton/Windsor/Briggsdale).*

The Child Protection Citizen Review Panel makes recommendations on grievances filed regarding the conduct of Human Services employees. This panel only meets when called and the time commitment is less than three hours annually. A limited background check is conducted prior to appointment on this panel. *Three positions available, at least one applicant must be the parent/guardian of a minor child.*

The Board of Public Health approves bio-solid and individual sewage disposal system applications and holds hearings related to applications. Meetings are held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 9:00 a.m., and the time commitment is three hours monthly. *Two positions are at-large, one position is for an applicant who lives in School District RE-5J, RE-1, RE-1J, or RE-2J, and one position is for an applicant who lives in School District RE-6, east of 14th Ave.*

The Noxious Weed Management Advisory Board advises county commissioners regarding integrated weed management on county and private property. Members must live within the unincorporated part of the county. This board meets on the third Thursday, quarterly, at 7:00 p.m., and the time commitment is 8 hours annually.
