### APPLICATIONS BEING ACCEPTED FOR SEVERAL WELD COUNTY BOARDS

WELD COUNTY, CO – The Weld County Commissioners are seeking Weld County residents interested in volunteering to serve on the: Board of Trustees for North Colorado Medical Center, Child Protection Citizen Review Panel, Workforce Development Board, Fair Board, and the Board of Public Health.

**The Board of Trustees for North Colorado Medical Center** administers the lease of the hospital to North Colorado Medical Center, Inc. The Board serves as a liaison between NCMC, Inc., and the County Commissioners, and works to identify community needs concerning hospital services. Applicants for this position must live outside of the municipal limits of the City of Greeley. Meetings are held the last Monday of each month at noon, and the time commitment is two hours monthly.

**The Child Protection Citizen Review Panel** makes recommendations on grievances filed regarding the conduct of Human Services employees. This panel only meets when called and the time commitment is less than three hours annually. A limited background check is conducted prior to appointment on this panel.

**The Workforce Development Board** contains community and business representatives which develop and implement system and program strategic planning on broad labor market issues and long-range outcomes for Employment Services of Weld County. This Board meets the third Tuesday, quarterly, at 11:30 a.m., and the time commitment is three hours monthly.

The **Fair Board** conducts the Weld County Fair. The fair is an annual event held for the educational benefit of 4-H, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, and FFA, and to showcase the Weld County community. The board meets at 7:00 p.m. on the first Monday of each month. Extensive involvement during the fair is expected, and the monthly time commitment is four hours. **The Board of Public Health** approves bio-solid and individual sewage disposal system applications and holds hearings related to applications. Applicants for this position must live in School District RE-6 (east of 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Evans or Greeley) or in School District RE-7 (Kersey/Gill/Barnesville area). Meetings are held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 9:00 a.m. The time commitment is three hours monthly.
