WELD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RECOGNIZE MIKE KETTERLING FOR HIS WORK AT ISLAND GROVE REGIONAL PARK

WELD COUNTY, CO – During their Monday meeting, the Weld County Board of Commissioners recognized Mike Ketterling with Ketterling, Butherus & Norton (KBN) Engineering, LLC, for his pro bono work at Island Grove Regional Park. In 2015, KBN Engineers assisted the county by creating construction documents and coordinating with the City of Greeley Water and Sewer Department to allow Island Grove's livestock show preparation area to have a drain line tied into Greeley's sanitary sewer system.
