COMMISSIONERS SEEK APPLICANTS FOR LOCAL BOARDS

WELD COUNTY, CO – The Weld County Commissioners are seeking Weld County residents interested in volunteering to serve on the following boards:

The Board of Adjustment conducts hearings and decides appeals from decisions concerning the administration or enforcement of the Weld County Zoning Ordinance. Interprets the location of zoning district boundaries and lot lines with respect to those boundaries. Time commitment 6 hours annually. Meets, when called, on first Tuesdays of month at 11:00 a.m.

The Board of Public Health approves bio-solid and individual sewage disposal system applications and holds hearings related to applications. Meetings are held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 9:00 a.m., and the time commitment is three hours monthly. *One position is at-large, one position is for an applicant who lives in School District 6.

Families, Youth, and Children Commission advises county commissioners regarding various areas of child welfare, primarily services to families and children. Meetings are scheduled quarterly with monthly subcommittee meetings. Time commitment 3 hours monthly. Meets quarterly, the second Friday at 7:30 a.m. *This position is for a clinic nurse.

Fair Board conducts the Weld County Fair. Junior exhibits of Weld County 4-H and FFA programs and open class competitions participate in the fair and consists of 21 members with three-year terms. Meets monthly the 1st Monday at 7:00 p.m. Time commitment 4 hours monthly plus fair participation.

Extension Advisory Council advises the Extension Service regarding their program efforts and budget decisions. Provides participation in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of Extension programs. Serves as a communication link between legislators, commissioners, and citizens. Time commitment 3 hours monthly. Meets the third Thursday of every other month at noon. *This position is for a Master Gardener.

Weld Faith Partnership Council advises county commissioners on strategic recommendations from a faith-based and community-based perspective regarding issues of concern. Up to 15 members including geographic representation of the faith community. Meets monthly the 2nd Thursday at 7:30 a.m. Time commitment is 2 hours monthly.

Workforce Development Board are owners, Chief Executive Officers and individuals in the local area with optimum policy making or hiring authority and leaders from the workforce system, education and economic development are charged with identifying regional workforce needs, developing and implementing systems in response and providing overall direction for Employment Services of Weld County. Time commitment averages 3 hours a month. General meetings convene six times per year on Tuesdays at 11:15 a.m. and sub-committees meet 3-4 times per year. *This positions is for a Large Business Representative.
