STATEWIDE

- Need suppression sustainability for months
- Ensure ability to care for the sick – COVID and Non COVID
- Achieve success in preventing infection in people who are high risk – older people and people in facilities
- Reduce social emotional and economic disruptions

WELD COUNTY

- Suppressing the virus in Weld
- Investigations and monitoring to contain what we have so that people stay safe and health care systems do not get over run
- Testing availability
- We need to think about how we can have prevent spread through social distancing on an ongoing basis

What has been
happening

Weld COVID Hotline

- Taken over 1,200 calls
- 60% residents / 40% businesses
- Some calls involve one or more contacts

Communication and Outreach

- Over 200 substantive communications not including these town halls and all social media interactions

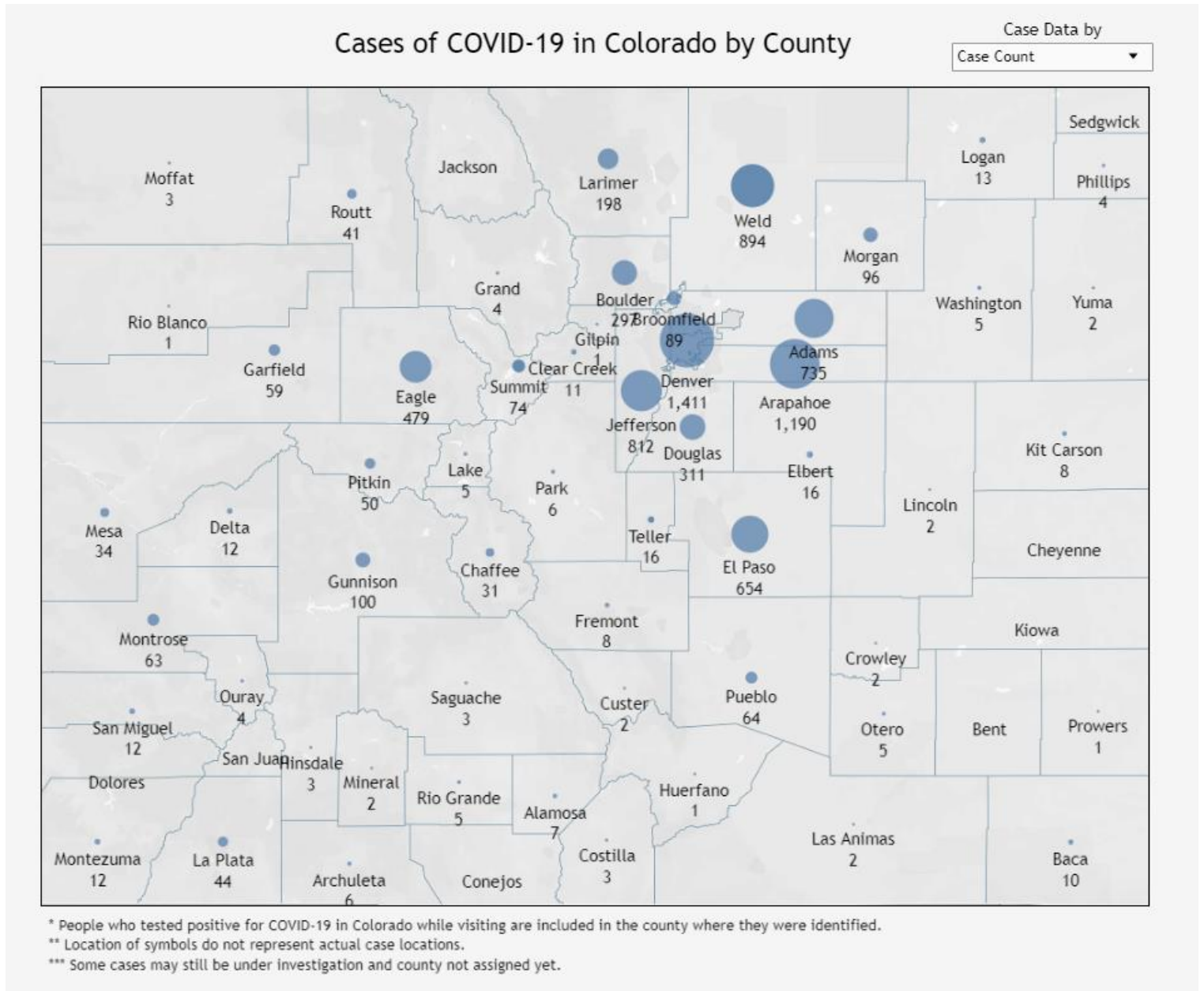

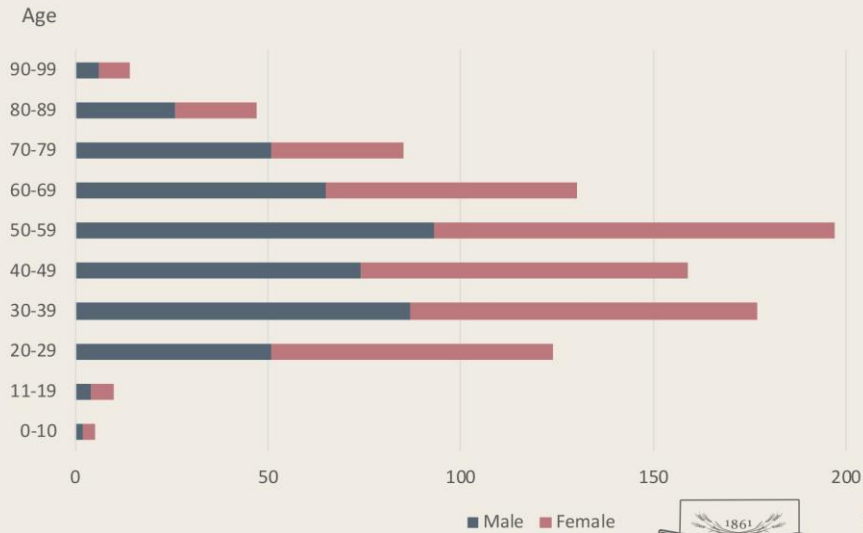

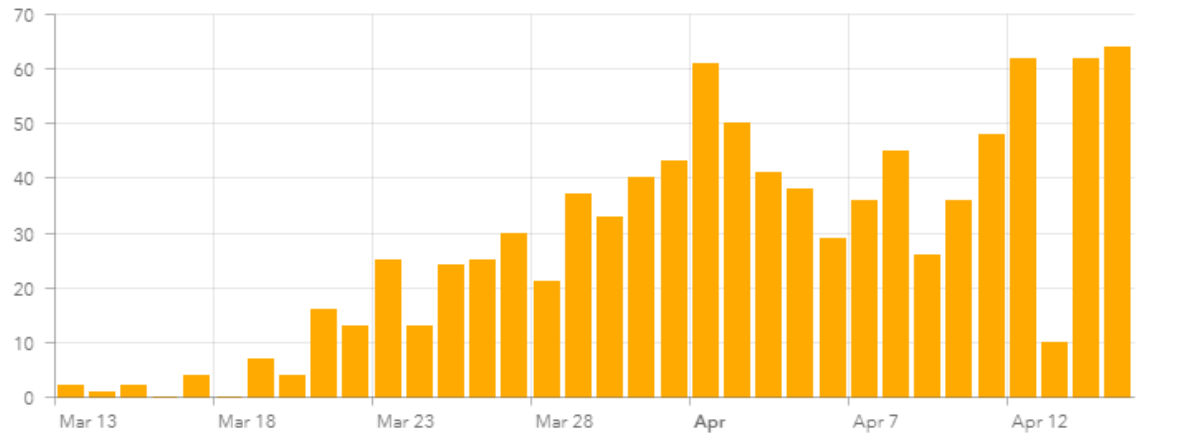
