Here to Help Meet Your Long Term Care Needs

The Weld County Area Agency on Aging Options for Long Term Care provides the following services:

- Information about long term care and other services in your community
- Comprehensive assessment of your needs for services
- Assistance with application process
- Program eligibility determination
- Care plan development
- Case management and coordination by a Personal Care Manager
- Direct connection or referral to appropriate services
- Follow-up to assure client satisfaction and service quality

Personal Care Managers use the following 5-step program:

Assessment: We do a complete in-home evaluation of social, emotional and physical functioning, support systems, family needs and economic considerations.

Personal Care Plan Development: Our Care Managers work with the client and family to identify community services to meet individual needs.

Coordination of Services: We schedule and customize services according to your Personal Care Plan.

Follow-Up/Evaluation: We assure that the services are properly provided according to your care plan. Additionally, we provide continuing assessment to meet changing needs.

Assistance and Guidance: Our Care Managers provide on-going emotional and social support to clients and family members.



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
