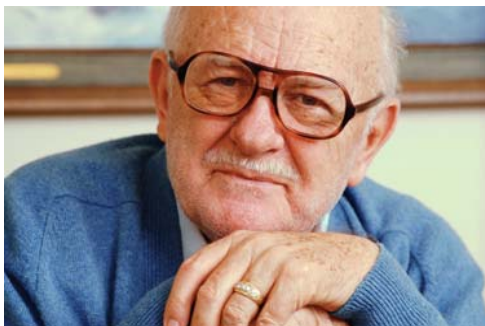

About the Program:

The purpose of the Chore Service Program is to provide low-income seniors funds available for chore services. These Chore Services are designed to increase the safety of the individuals living at home. These are services in which they are unable to provide for themselves.

Who's Eligible?

- Persons sixty (60) years of age or older
- Weld County resident
- Low-Income
- Unable to perform services by self



Services:

Services may include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Cleaning appliances: including ovens, defrosting and cleaning refrigerator, etc
2. Cleaning and securing carpet and rugs
3. Cleaning and waxing wood or walls
4. Washing windows or walls
5. Moving or rearranging furniture to provide safe entry and mobility
6. Cleaning attics, basements, porches and outbuildings to remove fire and health hazards
7. Installing or removing existing screens, storm doors or windows
8. Replacing fuses, light bulbs, repairing electric plugs or frayed cords
9. Grass cutting or leaf raking
10. Clearing walkways of ice, snow and leaves
11. Trimming overhanging tree branches
12. Changing batteries in smoke or carbon monoxide detectors
