

On-the-Job Training (OJT)

a service to employers and job seekers

Employment Services of Weld County is currently focusing on an effort to connect job seekers to employers offering highly skilled, full time jobs that pay a living wage. This opportunity is for motivated job seekers who have some skills, education and work history, but may be lacking some of the skills or experience they need to obtain the career they desire.



Qualified Workers:

On-the-Job training is available to those who are unemployed, underemployed, or working only part time. OJT participants must be motivated in their efforts to find employment, and willing to learn new and valuable skills that can lead to a well paying career. Anyone who feels that they are lacking the skills they need to obtain a living wage job can benefit from OJT.

Job Seeker Eligibility Requirements:

- You must receive core services from ESWC, which include initial assessments and an individual employment plan
- You must be lacking some of the skills or the experience necessary to obtain a position in your desired field
- Eligibility is ultimately determined by Employment Services of Weld County.

- Meet with a case manager to discuss your job search and barriers to employment
- Complete ESWC core services
- Ask your case manager to refer you to On-the-Job Training
