

Computer resources throughout Weld County:

1. High Plains Library: 1939 61st Ave, Greeley, CO (970) 506-8550

Members (those who have library cards) are allowed up to two hours of internet usage per day. Head sets are available.

2. Farr Regional Library: 1939 61st Ave, Greeley, CO (970) 506-8500

Members are allowed to use internet for up to one hour at a time with a reservation that they can get by using their library card. They can use up to 4 hours of internet usage per day with reservations. The library does have some headphones, but a lot of them are broken and the library is not able to replace them yet due to budget cuts. Members are welcome to bring in their own headphones or purchase ear buds at the front desk for \$1.00.

3. Centennial Park Library: 2227 23rd Ave, Greeley, CO (970) 506-8600

Members of ages 13 or older are able to reserve an internet space for up to one hour with a maximum of four hours per day. Headphones are available.

4. University of Northern Colorado Library: 2901 S 27th Ave, Greeley, CO (970) 351-2439

There are four open computers available to the public with internet capability. The other computers are strictly for students. There is only one set of head phones for all four computers. There is not a time limit for the computers.

5. Lincoln Park Library : 919 7th Street Greeley, CO 80631 (970) 506-8460

Person must be a member in order to use their computers. Must use library card to reserve a computer and community members are only allowed up to one hour of internet usage per day. All computers do have head sets.

6. James A. Michener Library: 501 20th St, Greeley, CO (970) 351-2671

There are between 6-8 computers that are available to the public with a two hour time limit. The students come first, so if a student would need a computer that a community member is sitting at, then that person would be asked to get off. Headsets are available for purchase for \$1.00. Community members do not have to have a library card to use the 6-8 computers that are open to the public.

7. Eaton Library: 132 Maple Ave, Eaton, CO (970) 454-2189

Community Members are able to use the computer for up to two hours with a library card. Headsets are available.

8. Northern Plains Public Library : 216 2ND STREET, Ault, CO 80610 (970) 834-1259

Community Members are able to use the computers. There is not any time limit for the computers and all computers come with head sets.

9. Aims Community College - Greeley - Greeley, CO 80634 | (970) 330-8008

Community Members are always welcome to use the computers at the Student Center, located on the second floor. There is not any time limit on how long a person can use the computer and/or internet. Headsets are available. The community member does not have to be a student to access these computers.

10. Windsor Severance Library: 720 3rd St, Windsor, CO 80550 (970) 686-5603

Must have a library card or the library can issue out guest passes for the computers. The computers are set up in one hour increments, with a maximum of usage of two hours per day. Card holders are the only ones that are able to rent headsets.

11. Platteville Public Library: 504 Marion Ave, Platteville, CO 80651 (970) 785-2231

Adults do not need to have a library card. Computers and internet usage starts at one hour, but can ask for longer times. Headsets are available.

12. Glenn A Jones Memorial Library: 400 S Parish Ave, Johnstown, CO (970) 587- 2459

Members are allowed one hour maximum time on internet, but can ask for more time if needed. Headsets are not available.

13. Loveland Public Library: 300 Adams Ave, Loveland, CO 80537

(970) 962-2665

Community members must have library card. Computers/Internet can be used for two hours per day. Headsets must be checked out with library card.

14. Employment Services of Weld County Resource Room: 315 B 11th Ave. (970)353-3800

Community Members can use computers and approved internet sites to look for employment. They can also ask for referral numbers for jobs that are posted. There is a free printer, scanner, copier and fax machine. There is also a phone available for community members to use for job related purposes..

15. The Carbon Valley Regional Library: 7 park Ave, Fredrick, CO (720)685-5100

Community Members can use computers to apply for jobs. There are headsets available for people that need them. Carbon Valley Regional Center is also offering a program called Job Zone that consists of volunteers personally assisting community members in their job search needs including resumes, cover letters, online applications and networking tools.
