As an Engineer Tech III, Marquez serves as a construction inspector for the WCR 49 Parkway Project. His main responsibility is to monitor and track the labor and materials being used on the project. He is also responsible for testing soil, asphalt and concrete for road and bridge crews. Soil testing is crucial as it is critical to know the type and strength of soil below the proposed road in order to ensure proper design and safety for the road's foundation and structures.

completion," said Marquez. "It is also rewarding to see the traveling public use and enjoy what we have built."
