Disabled Veterans License Plates

Veterans are eligible to get Disabled Veterans License plates at no cost, if they meet the requirements set by the Department of Veterans Affairs and the State of Colorado, Department of Revenue. Veteran must be 50% or more permanent and totally disabled. Veteran must also complete a Military License Plate Application, have a copy of their DD214, Eligibility Letter from the Denver VA, Registration or Title, Proof of Insurance and Emissions test (if required). To apply for the Eligibility Letter, please contact the Weld County Veterans Service Office.
