

Top Five Toxic Plants to Livestock in Weld County

A lot of plants can make livestock and wildlife sick if the plants are eaten. Influences on toxicity include plant growth stage, growing conditions, the animal species and the life stage of the animal. There are five top plants that are especially deadly for livestock in Weld County. These species are Poison Hemlock (a list C noxious weed), Death Camas (native), Suckleya (native), Jimsonweed (introduced), and Geyer Larkspur (native).
